

CFAC'S THREE NEW PROGRAMS (LEARN TO PLAY)

LOANERS FOR LEARNERS PROGRAM

CFAC offers a 12-bass accordion as a free loaner for three (3) months to any youth/student between the ages of 6 through 18 years of age wishing to learn to play the accordion whether through professional teaching or by self-teaching. To qualify, the youth/student must become a youth/student member of CFAC at a special rate of \$10 per year.

Student members will pick up and return accordions at a regular meeting of the Orlando Founding Chapter of CFAC. No security deposit is required. However, the youth/student member's parent/guardian is required to sign a Loaner Agreement.

Self-teaching student members may provide their own study material or purchase study material, if available, from CFAC at cost.

ACCORDION RENTAL PROGRAM

CFAC members can rent accordions for a period of no less than one month nor more than three months. Extensions of the rental period for more than three months will be determined on an individual basis by the Rental Program Administrator.

Rental accordions must be picked up and returned to the Orlando Founding Chapter at a regular meeting. Rental fees are payable in advance for one month or longer. The member or the parent/guardian of a youth/student member is required to sign a Rental Agreement.

Rental accordions may be available at a rental fee commensurate with the instrument's Pre-established Value.

CFAC rental accordions available under the Accordion Rental Program for Members will have a Pre-established Value as determined by the Central Florida Accordion Club.

The Pre-established Value shall serve as the loss basis in the event of misuse, damage or loss and as the purchase price should the accordion be available for sale. Members who rent an accordion will be entitled to receive 50 percent of their paid rentals fees as credit toward the Pre-established Value purchase price of the accordion being

rented or another CFAC accordion that may be available for sale. The Pre-established Value as a loss basis or purchase price is firm – no negotiating!

TELEPHONE TUTOR (TT) PROGRAM

The Telephone Tutor Program is available to CFAC members of any age who wish to learn to play the accordion by the self-teaching method. It is not available to members taking lessons from professional teachers. Under this program CFAC members (not professional teachers) will serve as volunteers (TTs) and will assist, answer questions, and/or give guidance via the telephone, internet, or other electronic devices. Contacts with TTs will be at the convenience of the TTs. The TTs can discontinue their services at any time for any reason.

Members learning to play under the self-teaching method may use their own study materials or purchase study materials from the CFAC at cost, if available.
